

By southern Ohio we mean that part of the state which lies south of the old National Road. This line is selected because for many years it was to Ohio politics what Mason and Dixon s line was to national politics - a line of cleavage. Although sectionalism is not our theme, yet it seems necessary at the outset to point out that on the slavery question in the state were those whose views ranged from a desire for a qualified form of slavery to immediate abolition. Ohio is at once the home of the Western Reserve and the Virginia Military District - the former settled by New Englanders whose hatred for slavery was deep seated, the latter populated mainly by sons of the South, especially from Kentucky, Virginia, Maryland and North Carolina. To be sure, some of these settlers came here to escape from the curse of slavery, and were its bitter opponents. This is especially true of the Quakers who left for free soil. On the other hand many - a large majority - because of kinship,...
