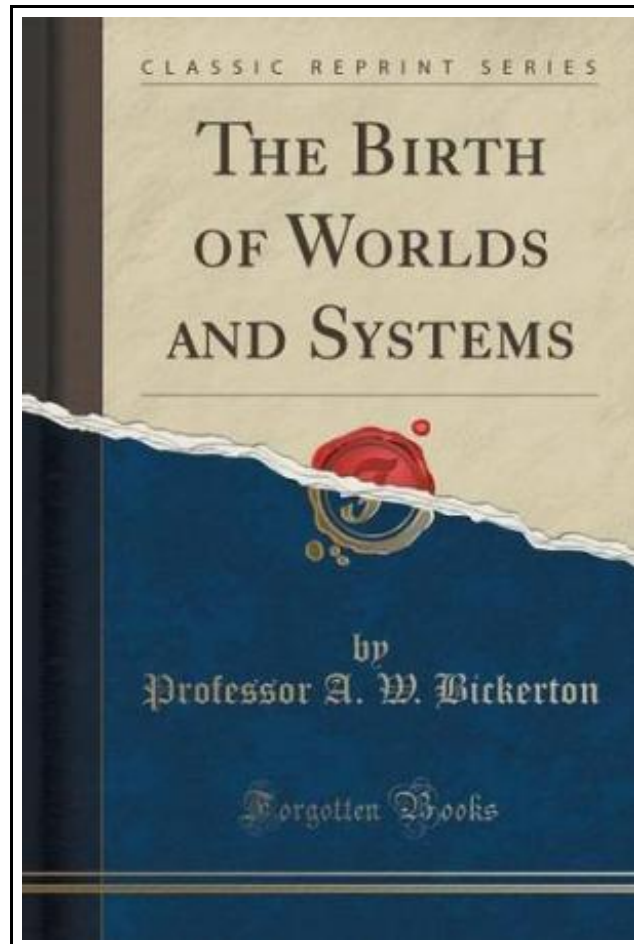

More than thirty years ago Professor Bickerton published in the New Zealand Philosophical Institute a theory to account for the origin and life history of new stars. It is now thought by many that the birth of new stars must be due to some kind of impact between two celestial bodies. This point of view was taken thirty years ago by Professor Bickerton.
